

## Olga Jonsson

Olga Otielle Rosentretter Jonsson, 89, died Friday, Jan. 30, 1987, in the American Fork Hospital of causes incident to cancer.

She was born Jan. 29, 1898, in the town of Gorodetskaya, near Kiev, Russia, to Julius and Anna Marie Luening. She married Wilhelm J. Wiest in 1919. He died in 1957.

The fortunes of social unrest and war have driven her across Russia, Poland, Austria and East Germany and finally for a temporary respite in West Germany. There she joined the LDS Church and has enjoyed being an active



member.

In 1960 she married John F. Jonsson, a naturalized citizen of the United States, formerly of Mildstedt, Germany, and came to live in Highland.

All of her life she has enjoyed working on the land and tending farm animals. Her second

husband preceded her in death in 1976.

She is survived by four sons and one daughter: Horst Wiest, West Germany; Paul Fred Jonsson, Lehi; Dr. Jens J. Jonsson, Provo; Lawrence Jonsson, Highland; and Mrs. Mary Ann Young, Tooele; and two sisters in West Germany.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, Feb. 7, at 11 a.m. in the Highland 5th and 10th Ward, 10400 N. 6000 West, where friends may call one hour prior to services.

Burial will be in the American Fork City Cemetery.
